WHEREAS Nova Scotia Power Incorporated (“NSPI”) applied to the Nova Scotia Utility and Review Board (the “Board”) for approval to amend Regulation 3.6 – Net Metering by enhancing its net metering service, in compliance with recent legislative changes to the *Electricity Act*, to provide for expanded customer capacity, aggregated metering and payment for annual excess generation.

AND WHEREAS by Notice dated November 3, 2010, interested parties were asked to file a Notice of Intention to Participate by December 9, 2010;

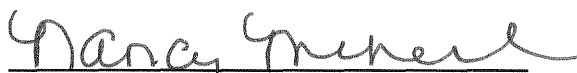
AND WHEREAS several parties have filed a Notice of Intention to Participate;
