Re: M06733 - EfficiencyOne – Application for Approval of a Supply Agreement for Electricity Efficiency and Conservation Activities between EfficiencyOne and Nova Scotia Power Inc., the establishment of a final agreement between the Parties and approval of a 2016-2018 Demand Side Management ("DSM") Plan – E-ENSC-R - 15

Revised Evidence of EfficiencyOne

EfficiencyOne has been made aware of cell reference errors in its response to Synapse IR-17, Attachment 1 (filed electronically): the 50% Low Alternate Scenario referenced zero avoided costs. While avoided costs have not been calculated for this scenario, as stated in Appendix D to its Evidence (page 9, lines 29-30) to be conservative in its analysis, EfficiencyOne intended to reference the Low DSM Scenario avoided costs, although these are higher than would be expected in a 50% Low Scenario. This cell reference has now been fixed, as has a reference for the Municipal Class that was one year off for the calculation of alternative rate impacts. Doing so has caused revisions to EfficiencyOne's Evidence (Appendix D, Attachment 3): average rate impacts for the 50% Low alternate scenario are now lower than indicated in the prior outputs. The Municipal Class rate impacts for all scenarios have also changed.

For ease of reference throughout this proceeding, EfficiencyOne has also added page numbers to Appendix C, Attachments 1 and 2; and Appendix D, Attachment 3.

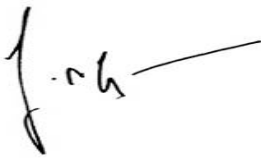
