EfficiencyOne has reviewed the Notice of Intention to Participate filed by the Nova Scotia Municipal Electric Utilities of Nova Scotia Cooperative received on June 8, 2015 in respect to the above-noted hearing.

In reviewing the Notice, EfficiencyOne considered both the value of and respect for all stakeholder perspectives and the Board process designed to ensure an effective outcome. Based on these considerations, EfficiencyOne respectfully objects to the addition of the Nova Scotia Municipal Electric Utilities of Nova Scotia Cooperative as a formal intervenor to this proceeding. This objection is based upon:

- (a) the lateness of the Application; and
- (b) potential prejudice to the Co-Applicant.

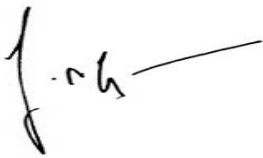
