M06733 – EfficiencyOne – Application for Approval of a Supply Agreement for Electricity Efficiency and Conservation Activities between EfficiencyOne and Nova Scotia Power Inc., the establishment of a final agreement between the parties and approval of a 2016-2018 Demand Side Management (“DSM”) Plan - E-ENSC-R-15

By email dated June 8, 2015, the Municipal Electric Utilities of Nova Scotia Cooperative (“MEUNSC”) filed a Notice of Intervention. The date for intervention, pursuant to the Board’s Amended Order dated March 13, 2015, was March 25, 2015. There was no explanation with the Notice of Intervention as to why it was late filed. The Board forwarded the Notice of Intervention to Nova Scotia Power Inc. (“NSPI”) and EfficiencyOne for comment. NSPI did not object to the late filing; EfficiencyOne did, as noted in the attached letter from EfficiencyOne’s counsel, Mr. Gogan. Mr. Gogan objects to the potential intervention because of:

- a) the lateness of the application to intervene
- b) the potential prejudice to the Co-Applicant

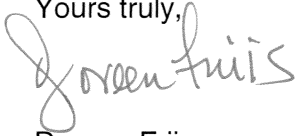
The Panel hearing this matter is Peter Gurnham, Kulvinder Dhillon, and Roberta Clarke.

The MEUNSC is an experienced participant in regulatory proceedings in this Province. The Notice of Hearing was duly advertised and there has been significant comment in the media in connection with the hearing through the course of the Spring.

In the circumstances, the Board does not grant the request to formally intervene by the MEUNSC because of the lateness of the request and the potential for prejudice to the Co-Applicant, EfficiencyOne.

The MEUNSC may address the Board at the evening session on June 15, 2015, and should so advise the Clerk if it intends to avail itself of that opportunity.
