Re: M07543 – EfficiencyOne 2016-2018 DSM Deferred Matters

This letter is to update the Board with respect to the status of further ongoing discussions between EfficiencyOne and various intervenor parties toward a final Consensus Agreement in relation to the 2016-2018 DSM Plan Application deferred matters.

On June 30, 2016, EfficiencyOne filed a Consensus Agreement which was signed by the following parties:

Municipal Electric Utilities of Nova Scotia
Affordable Energy Coalition
Ecology Action Centre

Subsequently, we advised the Board that the Consumer Advocate had also agreed to execute the Consensus Agreement.

EfficiencyOne had requested that the Board grant a further period of time to allow it to continue consultations with the goal of broadening the Agreement to include all parties.

As a result of this further consultation, EfficiencyOne is now filing a revised Consensus Agreement. At the time of writing, the following parties have confirmed their support for this revised Agreement:

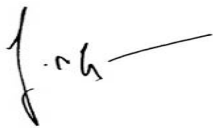

Upon receipt of confirmation from the remaining parties, EfficiencyOne undertakes to file the executed revised Consensus Agreement with the Board.
