I write on behalf of EfficiencyOne in relation to the above noted matter. EfficiencyOne respectfully requests the Board's consent to be added as a late Intervenor in this proceeding.

Upon review of the documentation filed to date, EfficiencyOne notes that the engagement of Synapse to undertake modelling as part of the effort to establish optimum generation plans going forward, will likely impact issues of direct interest to the operation of the utility. It appears that a portion of this effort will involve characterizing and modelling different levels of demand side management (DSM) activities.

EfficiencyOne was not anticipating the emergent nature of DSM as a topic of interest in this matter. Given EfficiencyOne's unique position as exclusive franchise holder, the utility would like the opportunity to comment on aspects of this proceeding that relate to DSM.
