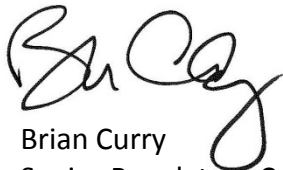
In its Order dated July 23, 2018 in connection with the above noted matter, the Nova Scotia Utility and Review Board (UARB) directed as follows:

6. NSPI is also directed to provide E1, and the DSM Advisory Group, its suggested revisions to the rate and bill impact analysis (RBIA) by September 30, 2018.

NS Power is still in the process of finalizing its recommendations with respect to EfficiencyOne's (E1) rate and bill impact analysis (RBIA). NS Power has consulted with E1 and wishes to inform the UARB that with E1's agreement, the Company will be providing E1 and the DSM Advisory Group with the Company's suggested recommendations to the RBIA by October 10, 2018.
