IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the following timetable recommended by EfficiencyOne be followed prior to ordering a new hearing date:

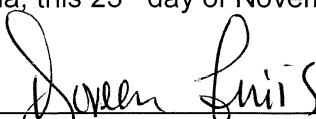
EfficiencyOne to develop a focused issues list in consultation with stakeholders	Q3 2019
