On January 21, 2020, the Board approved the Terms of Reference for the IRP, which included a schedule for milestones in the process.

NS Power has continued to work with Board staff and consultants and interested parties on developing and refining the Assumptions and Analysis Plan, and has held three conferences for stakeholders, on January 28, February 7 and February 27, 2020.

In the Terms of Reference, NS Power indicated the final Assumptions and Analysis Plan would be issued March 5, 2020. NS Power is continuing to finalize these items based on feedback received, wishes to advise the Board that these final documents will be issued on March 11, 2020, or before. This change will not affect the overall project schedule which concludes in September 2020.
