NOTICE OF PAPER HEARING

EfficiencyOne (E1) has made Application to the Nova Scotia Utility and Review Board for Approval of a Supply Agreement for Electricity Efficiency and Conservation Activities between E1 and Nova Scotia Power Inc, and the establishment of a final agreement between the parties, including approval of E1's 2023-2025 Demand Side Management (DSM) Resource Plan. The Resource Plan includes incremental cumulative net energy savings of 412.7 GWh and cumulative system peak demand savings of 96.7 MW, at a total investment level of \$173 million over the three-year period.

The Board will consider this matter in a paper hearing process.

- You may request formal standing as an Intervenor, subject to Board approval. Your request must be received by the Board by **Tuesday, March 29, 2022**, and a copy of your written evidence by **Friday, May 20, 2022**.
