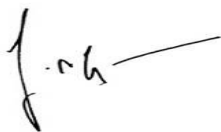
I write further to the September 6, 2022, decision of the Nova Scotia Utility and Review Board ("Board") in relation to the above noted matter. In its Decision, the Board directed EfficiencyOne to make its Compliance Filing, including the executed Supply Agreement, no later than September 20, 2022.

As the Board is aware, Nova Scotia Power's general rate application ("GRA") hearing commenced on September 12, 2022, and is continuing daily before the Board. EfficiencyOne is an intervening participant in this hearing as well.

In consideration of the Parties' participation in the ongoing GRA hearing, EfficiencyOne and NS Power are respectfully requesting a two-week extension within which to submit the Compliance Filing, including the executed Supply Agreement relating thereto, to the Board.
