The Small Business Advocate represents 3 classes of small business (namely 10, 11, and 21 - small business; general; small industrial) whose interests may be affected by this Application.

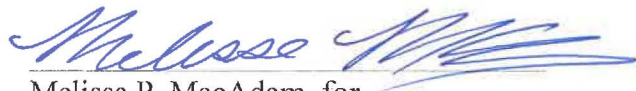
