Re: M12339 Renewall Energy Inc. – Request for Tariffs for the Renewable to Retail Market – Extension Request

Dear Ms. Henwood:

By Order, the Nova Scotia Energy Board (NSEB, Board) directed Nova Scotia Power Inc. (NS Power, Company) to engage with interested parties under s. 22(1) of the *Electricity Act* to develop or amend any tariffs, procedures, or standards of conduct necessary to enable distribution-connected generation and net billing, and to file an application for approval by April 1, 2026. By letter dated March 3, 2026, NS Power requested an extension of that deadline. The Board approved that request by letter dated March 5, 2026, extending the filing deadline to May 1, 2026.

Following consultation with Renewall Energy Inc. (REI), NS Power retained Power Advisory to support this work and facilitate engagement with interested parties. NS Power has continued to advance this process in accordance with the Board's direction. Power Advisory circulated draft documents to REI and NS Power on March 13, 2026. The Company's consolidated comments on the consultant's materials were circulated to Power Advisory and REI on April 17, 2026.

However, as of today, REI has not provided comments on Power Advisory's draft documents. These comments are an important input to the collaborative completion of the remaining work and the finalization of the proposed tariffs and associated materials. As a result, NS Power will not be in a position to meet the May 1, 2026 filing deadline.

To allow for the receipt and consideration of outstanding feedback and to complete the stakeholder engagement process contemplated by the Board's Order, NS Power respectfully requests that the application deadline be extended to June 1, 2026. NS
