**M12339 - Renewall Energy Inc. - Request for Tariffs for the Renewable to Retail Market
- Extension Request**

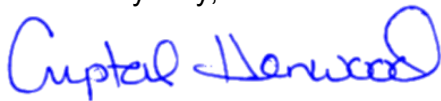
This will acknowledge receipt of NS Power's letter dated and received by the Board on June 1, 2026, requesting a further extension of its filing in this matter from June 1 to July 31, 2026.

The Board's Order in M12339 directed NS Power to engage with interested parties under s. 22(1) of the *Electricity Act* to develop or amend any tariffs, procedures, or standards of conduct necessary to enable distribution connected generation and net billing, and to file an application for approval by April 1, 2026. On March 5, 2026, the Board approved an extension request by NS Power, extending the filing deadline to May 1, 2026. On April 27, 2026, the Board approved NS Power's further extension request to June 1, 2026.

Upon receipt of the current extension request, the Board asked for comments from the parties by June 3, 2026, which were filed by Renewal, the Consumer Advocate and the Small Business Advocate. No one opposed the extension. NS Power stated that its proposed timeline and work plan "will promote a more complete and fully developed application record, support organizational and stakeholder alignment where possible, and improve the efficiency and effectiveness of the regulatory review process to the benefit of all parties."

The Board approves NS Power's extension request. The deadline for filing the application is now July 31, 2026, with the understanding that if NS Power can submit the application earlier it will do so.
