Re: M12293/M12436 – NERC Quarterly Application for Approval of Reliability Standards – First and Second Quarter 2025 – Extension Request

Dear Ms. Henwood:

On October 23, 2025, the Nova Scotia Energy Board (NSEB, Board) provided the following direction to Nova Scotia Power (NS Power, Company) by letter regarding the above-noted matters:

...to address the statutory requirements, before making a final determination, the Board would ask that NS Power provide any information or estimates on the costs associated with implementing the reliability standards submitted by NERC for approval in matters M12293 and M12436 and NS Power's position on whether this range of costs is justified in the circumstances.

The Board requests a response by Monday, November 17, 2025.¹

NS Power is in the process of compiling the information requested by the NSEB, but requires additional time due to resources constraints. Accordingly, the Company respectfully requests an extension to submit compliance with the Board's direction to December 1, 2025.
