NOTICE OF APPLICATION

TO: The Nova Scotia Energy Board

1. Nova Scotia Power Incorporated (NS Power, the Company) is a public utility subject to regulation by the Nova Scotia Energy Board (NSEB, the Board) and conducts its business in Nova Scotia where it is engaged in the generation, distribution and transmission of electrical power.
2. General electricity rates were last adjusted by Board Order dated February 2, 2023, which effected rate increases for the years 2023 and 2024. Since that date there have been material changes in circumstances for the test years 2026-2027.
3. The Company therefore makes this Application, with the support of customer representatives, for certain revisions to its rates, charges, and regulations, effective January 1, 2026 and January 1, 2027.
4. Filed in support of this Application is the Direct Evidence of NS Power. The Direct Evidence includes Appendices containing additional material supporting the Application. In addition, the Company has filed supporting information as prescribed in the Standardized

3 5. There are regulatory proceedings ongoing or anticipated at the time of this Application that
4 could affect the test year revenue requirement. This Application does not account for any
5 additional spending (revenue requirement) that may result from external cost pressures,
6 decisions by the NSEB, or from additional directives that may be ordered by the NSEB as
7 a result of this Application. Any such changes will be incorporated in the Compliance
8 Filing, subject to NSEB approval.

9 6. On the evidence filed in support of this Application, NS Power asserts that the Order sought
10 by the Application is in the public interest and in the interest of NS Power.

11 7. NS Power therefore seeks an Order granting the relief requested in the Application.
