M12551 – 2026 Annually Adjusted Rates – Compliance Filing

The Nova Scotia Energy Board's decision dated March 9, 2026, approved the 2026 Annually Adjusted Rates (AARs) effective April 1, 2026. The Board retained its jurisdiction to amend the AARs, effective April 1, 2026, following the outcome of the updated Cost of Service Study in the Nova Scotia Power Inc. (NS Power) 2026-2027 General Rate Application (GRA) matter M12451.

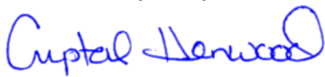
In the Board's decision, NS Power was directed to update the 2026 AARs to reflect any changes made to the Cost-of-Service Study through a compliance filing following the Board's decision on the 2026-2027 GRA. On April 30, 2026, the Board issued its order on the 2026-2027 GRA.

NS Power filed its compliance filing with the Board on May 11, 2026, with revisions to seven AARs.

The panel considering this matter is Richard J. Melanson, LL.B., Panel Chair; Jennifer L. Nicholson, CPA, CA, Member; and Bruce H. Fisher, CPA, Member.

The Board has reviewed the compliance filing and invites comments from interested parties on the impact of the changes to the AARs arising from the revised Cost-of-Service Study. Comments will be accepted by the Board by Monday May 25, 2026, and in accordance with the Board Regulatory Rules, these filings are due by 2:00 p.m.
