Dear Ms. Henwood:

Below please find Nova Scotia Power Inc.'s (NS Power, Company) proposed tariffs for the Annually Adjusted Rates (AAR) for 2026, including cost support, and proposed redline and clean tariffs for:

1. Generation Replacement and Load Following Tariff;
2. One Part Transmission Real Time Pricing Tariff;
3. One Part Distribution Voltage Real Time Pricing Tariff;
4. Shore Power Tariff;
5. Wholesale Market Back-up/Top-Up Service Tariff;
6. Wholesale Market Non-Dispatchable Supplier Tariff;
7. Renewable to Retail Energy Balancing Service Tariff;
8. Renewable to Retail Standby Service Tariff;
9. Renewable to Retail Market Transition Tariff; and
10. Extra Large Industrial Active Demand Control Tariff.
