TO: The Nova Scotia Energy Board ("Board")

AND TO: Nova Scotia Power Incorporated ("NS Power")

1. The **BERWICK ELECTRIC COMMISSION**, the **RIVERPORT ELECTRIC LIGHT COMMISSION**, the **TOWN OF MAHONE BAY**, and the **TOWN OF ANTIGONISH** (collectively, the "MEUs") purchase power and energy from Nova Scotia Power Inc. under the Municipal rate and the BUTU rate. The MEUs are also directly impacted by the rates and charges pursuant to the Spill Tariff through the ownership of, and their direct relationship with, the sole customer taking service under the Spill Tariff.
2. As a result of the foregoing, the MEUs have an interest in this matter and in the proceedings before the Board in connection therewith.
3. The MEUs requests that they be granted status as an Intervenor in the Hearing in connection with this matter.
