The Consumer Advocate represents the interests of residential ratepayers, who may be impacted by this Application.

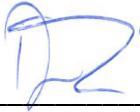
The Consumer Advocate will address the issues identified by the Energy Board and such other issues as may arise during the course of the proceeding.
