Re: M12661 Extra Large Industrial Dispatchable (ELID) Tariff – Technical Conference

Dear Ms. Henwood:

Nova Scotia Power (NS Power, Company) filed an Application for Approval of an Above-the-Line (ATL) Tariff applicable to Port Hawkesbury Paper (PHP) on December 29, 2025. Following the Company's and PHP's April 10, 2026 responses to information requests (IRs), Counsel for the Industrial Group (IG) advised that questions remained with respect to the operation of the proposed tariff and requested an ELID Tariff technical conference with NS Power and PHP to address these matters.

NS Power and PHP have agreed to conduct a Technical Conference and, in collaboration with Customer Representatives (Consumer Advocate (CA), Small Business Advocate (SBA), IG, and Port Hawkesbury Paper (PHP)), have selected a date (Wednesday, April 29, 2026). Given the Board-established timeline currently provides for the filing of Intervenor and Board Counsel Consultant Evidence on Thursday, April 30, the Company suggests the date for filing this evidence could be extended a week to Thursday, May 7 with no further adjustments to the Board-established timeline for this proceeding.

Prior to filing this correspondence, the Company discussed this timeline shift with the parties registered in this proceeding (CA, SBA, IG, PHP, Nova Scotia Independent Energy System Operator, and EfficiencyOne) and all parties have confirmed their agreement on the process timeline shift. As well, an invitation to attend the Technical Conference has been extended to all parties and Board staff and Board staff consultants.

As this process remains an open Matter before the Board, NS Power will promptly file the materials from the April 29 Technical Conference with the NSEB for inclusion on the evidentiary record in this proceeding.
