Re: IESO Nova Scotia 2026/2027 Revenue Requirement and Fees Application Filing Date

Dear Ms. Henwood:

In accordance with Section 29(1) of the More Access to Energy Act (MAEA), the Independent Energy System Operator (IESO) of Nova Scotia is required to submit its proposed expenditure and revenue requirements for the fiscal year and the fees it proposes to charge during the fiscal year to the Nova Scotia Energy Board (NSEB, Board) for review by December 31st annually.

IESO Nova Scotia is writing to inform the NSEB that work is progressing steadily on the 2026/2027 Revenue Requirement and Fees application, and intends to submit the application to the NSEB by January 31, 2026, as permitted under Section 29(2), which provides as follows:

Where the IESO is unable to make its submission under sub- section (1) within the time required under that subsection, the IESO shall file its proposed expenditure and revenue requirements for the fiscal year and the fees it proposes to charge during the fiscal year to the Energy Board for review as soon as possible.¹
