Re: Green Choice Program – 2025 Reporting Requirements

Dear Ms. Henwood:

March 10, 2020 amendments to the *Electricity Act* (Act) introduced s. 4BA (now s. 30).¹ The Act was subsequently amended on April 22, 2022, establishing the Green Choice Program (GCP, Program).² The *Green Choice Program Regulations* (GCP Regulations), made under s. 32 of the Act, came into force on August 29, 2023. The GCP Regulations set out Nova Scotia Power Incorporated (NS Power, Company) reporting requirements; s. 23 provides:

On or before January 31 of each year, NSPI must provide a report to the Minister and the Board summarizing all of the following actions taken in the previous calendar year regarding the participants and power purchase agreements that are under the Green Choice Program:

- (a) any extension, assignment, transfer or termination of a subscription of a participant;
- (b) any transfer, assignment or termination of a power purchase agreement.³

In the 2025 Reporting Year, the Company continued to work with the Nova Scotia Department of Energy and the Procurement Administrator, Coho, to support the Program's development. NS Power provided updates to the Nova Scotia Energy Board (NSEB, Board) through the Path to 2030 Reports filed in compliance with the Board's directive of the 2023

Annual Capital Expenditures (ACE) Plan⁴ and, most recently, in the 2026 ACE Plan.⁵

The Company is writing to confirm that none of the actions contemplated under s. 23 of the GCP Regulations were undertaken in 2025 and therefore there is nothing to report pursuant to that provision.
