The Board can investigate whether NS Power is complying with the *Public Utilities Act*, any related regulations, or the utility's Board-approved Schedule of Rates and Regulations. This complaint appears to fall under that jurisdiction.

You are further advised that information regarding complaints filed with the Board is a matter of public record and, while the Board will redact all personal identifiers from its published documents, they can be accessed by others through the Board's public website and in an unredacted format at the offices of the Board.

The evidence you file in support of your complaint will also be a matter of public record unless you request that the Board hold some or all the evidence in confidence. **To do that you must apply to the Board in writing pursuant to *Regulatory Rule 12*, a copy of which is attached to this letter.** The evidence will, in any case, be made available to NS Power to allow the appeal to be properly addressed.

By copy of this letter, the Board requests NS Power to file a response with the Board to the enclosed complaint on or before **2:00 pm on Friday, February 27, 2026**. NS Power must also provide a copy of their response to the complainant.

As the complainant, you will have **10 business days** to respond to NS Power's filing should you wish to do so. The Board will then consider all information filed to determine if additional documentation is required.

After all correspondence has been received, the evidence portion of this complaint will be closed. The Board will review the information provided and will contact the parties should any further information be required. A Decision of the Board will follow in due course.
