1. Request IR-1 - Enphase App Records (2024 & 2025)

I did not provide records from my Enphase App for 2024, as I was appropriately credited by Nova Scotia Power for my excess solar generation during that year. There was no dispute regarding the amount of energy exported to the grid, and therefore no need to supplement the record with additional documentation.

Similarly, I did not provide Enphase App records for 2025 because Nova Scotia Power has not disputed the accuracy of the generation/export figures I have presented. The issue at hand is not about the validity of the data, but rather Nova Scotia Power's position that no compensation is owed for my excess solar generation. As such, providing additional supporting data from the Enphase system would not address the core issue in dispute.

2. Request IR-2 - Confirmation of Meter Accuracy

I did not request that Nova Scotia Power formally confirm the accuracy of the meter readings. The figures provided by Nova Scotia Power for both 2024 and 2025 were only marginally different from my own records, amounting to minor discrepancies of a small number of kWh. Given the minimal nature of these differences, I did not consider it necessary to pursue further verification.
