M12733 – NSPI DRO Appeal – Billing Issues – Dave Lincoln

This letter responds to your email correspondence dated April 21, 2026, which included various allegations and demands. Some of those allegations, including those relating to the *Human Rights Act*, *Consumer Protection Act*, and the class action proceeding in the Supreme Court of Nova Scotia, are not within the Board's jurisdiction to address.

The Board is continuing to process your complaint following its usual process and timelines as set out in its acknowledgement letter of March 5 and email to you of April 21, 2026. The Board acknowledgment letter also reiterates that any disconnection notices are on hold until the Board issues a decision.

At this stage, the Board has received various documents, including NS Power's response to the appeal (Exhibit L-7) and your comments on that response. The Board is reviewing these documents to determine if it requires additional information. The Board expects to issue information requests (IRs) to NS Power, and possibly yourself, seeking additional information, including copies of any payment agreements and relating to other issues raised by you in this appeal. Following the receipt of responses to those IRs, the Board will determine whether it requires further information or has enough information to make a decision.

With respect to your request for production of Exhibit L-7, that information was provided in NS Power's letter of March 19, which was copied to you. Also, your email of March 20, 2026, suggests that you received this exhibit. Regardless, it is attached for reference.
