Ms. Wallace and Board Staff,

Let this email serve as formal notice that due to the blatant bias, systemic collusion, and total failure of this body to perform its statutory duty, I am preparing to escalate this entire matter to the Nova Scotia Court of Appeal.

The Board is no longer operating as an impartial regulator. You are actively enabling a lawless monopoly to run wild, lie, cheat, and steal from citizens, completely disregarding the consumer protections mandated by utility regulations and the law.

I have done absolutely nothing wrong in this entire matter except bring to your attention the blatant regulatory non-compliance of a monopoly that is currently lying, cheating, and stealing from residents. Nova Scotia Power and a biased Dispute Resolution Officer (DRO) are the only parties who have committed wrongdoing, yet the Board continues to allow this clear unlawful corruption to move forward.

The evidence officially logged under Exhibit L-9 LINCOLN (NSEB) RIR-1 completely destroys Nova Scotia Power's credibility and proves they have lied from all sides. During the DRO hearings, they explicitly claimed my actual monthly usage baseline was \$496.00 a month. However, the September 2025 invoice they just submitted to this Board completely invalidates their own testimony. That invoice records my actual usage at \$4.30 a day,

which is exactly \$129.00 a month. This proves they fabricated their consumption metrics on the record to secure an enforcement order.

Furthermore, Nova Scotia Power has failed across four separate opportunities—twice before the DRO and twice before this Board—to produce a single contract or billing agreement. This includes the high-stakes third-party contract they admitted in writing to executing without my consent or Power of Attorney. Under basic contract law, because no signature exists, a valid agreement never existed. They had no legal authority to bind my finances, meaning the entire balance is a fraudulent nullity.

Their own documents prove they triple-billed my profile, charging my account \$4,818.00 for \$782.82 worth of actual, physical energy consumption over an overlapping 182-day summer timeline. A full forensic audit since my home purchase in September 2017 to the present day is mandatory, along with the immediate enforcement of full restitution for the thousands upon thousands of dollars stolen from my family under these unsigned structures.

To compound this exploitation, while Nova Scotia Power uses these ghost agreements to run an active, predatory \$1,776.00 collections clock due on June 8th, a widespread grid failure left over 6,200 homes across Greenwood, Kingston, and Aylesford in total darkness for over six consecutive hours today, Monday, May 25th from 4:03pm until 10:39pm. The attached screenshots from their own live outage map prove they cannot even deliver the basic power grid stability they are billing for.

Instead of ending this matter when the utility failed to produce the contracts, this Board has spent months ignoring my multiple explicit requests for a Stay of Enforcement. You have chosen to let a non-compliant monopoly retain stolen veteran income while forcing my family to endure active economic duress and intentional infliction of emotional distress. This continued stress is directly exacerbating my service-connected injuries, PTSD, and MDD.

If this Board does not immediately void this fabricated balance, halt Nova Scotia Power's collections clock, and issue an Immediate Emergency Stay Order by end of day Wednesday May 27th, the complete record of your regulatory failure and systemic collusion will be filed directly before the Nova Scotia Court of Appeal.

I will also note the Ombudsman for Nova Scotia has also sat back and watched this happen along with all of the elected officials. Im done with your games this is my family's livelihood that has been stolen from me from this non compliant lawless monopoly while you all sit back and ignore a disabled veteran that served his country and defended the rights and freedoms you all have while mine are actively destroyed. Shame on you all. There will be accountability coming i can promise you that you will never intimidate me nor get me to back down from what is a human right and legal standing for the protections i deserve just as much as everyone else.

You have all watched proof of NSP actively lying, proof of stolen funding between \$20000.00-\$50000.00. I cant make this any clearer they admitted to the incorrect amounts, they submitted the docs proving the lies and the theft. Its in black and white yet not a single person acts or does whats right? Clearly ethics and morals are not the priority of anyone involved in this entire chain its disgraceful, leaders are supposed to lead not kick disabled Veterans and vulnerable people that are already down. Ill let you in on one thing

though, my last name is Lincoln, the same name that abolished slavery, i will not back down until full accountability for all involved. Shame on all of you.

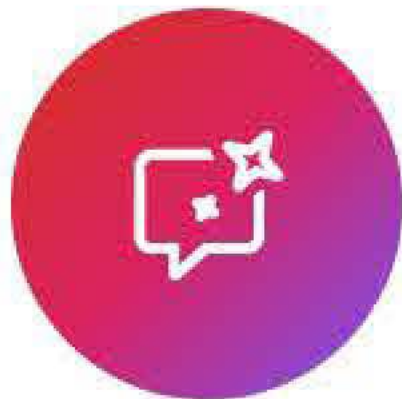

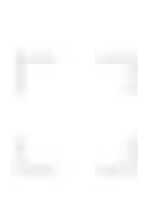

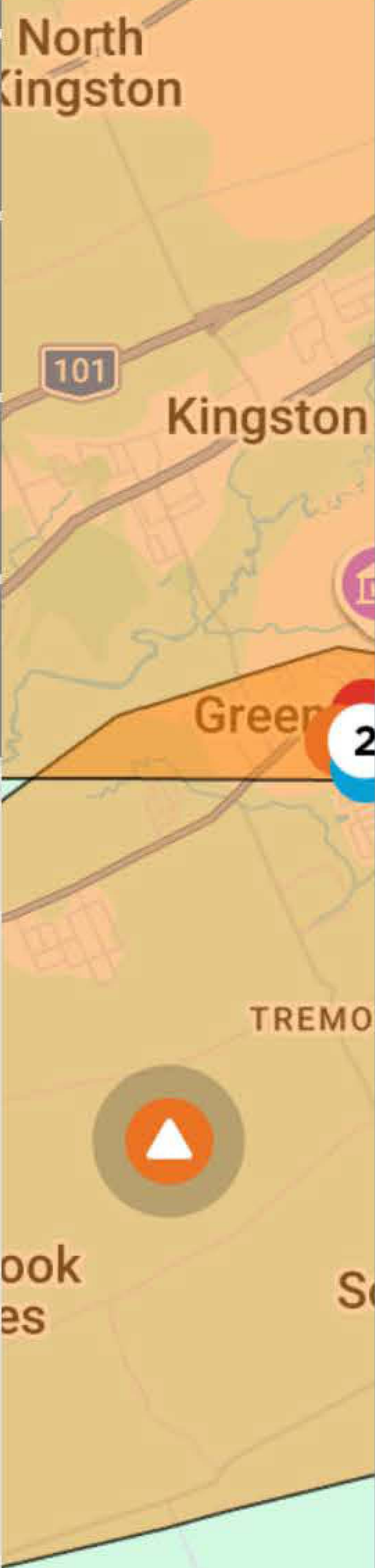
