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Request IR-3:

Please confirm whether the interconnection contract specifies that construction overruns, delay damages, permitting deficiencies, financing shortfalls, and site control failures are the developer’s responsibility and not recoverable from NS Power’s ratepayers. Please provide a supporting document to support this claim.

Response IR-3:

The cost responsibility for distribution connected generation projects under the Government of Nova Scotia’s Community Solar Program is outlined in Article 5 of the Standard Small Generator Interconnection and Operating Agreement (SSGIA). An excerpt from section 5.1.1 of the SSGIA states “The Interconnection Customer will be solely responsible to pay the actual costs incurred by the Distribution Provider in respect of the purchase, construction and maintenance, and all related activity provided for in this Agreement”. Please refer to IR-4 Attachment 2 for the full SSGIA. The relevant provisions are below for ease of reference:

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Request IR-7:

Once built and commissioned, will the project also provide benefits to NS Power's customers generally or is it only to benefit the solar generator?

Response IR-7:

The network upgrades included in this project are for the benefit of the solar generator interconnection customer only. All costs for the upgrade are the responsibility of the Interconnection Customer. Benefits to other NS Power customers are marginal, such as slightly improved voltage characteristics, phase balancing, or line integrity.

This project is part of the Province's Community Solar Program (CSP); as such, customers (including the Project Owner) may subscribe to energy from this generator and receive a bill credit in accordance with the *Community Solar Program Regulations* and the terms of the Board-approved Community Solar Energy Credit Rider (M11911).
