Request IR-1:

What will be the estimated annual maintenance, repair and replacement costs and sustaining costs for this project after it is commissioned?

Request IR-2:

Please confirm that metering and telemetry equipment or any other equipment that will be used to facilitate the power from this solar generation project will be paid by the solar developer?

Request IR-3:

Please confirm whether the interconnection contract specifies that construction overruns, delay damages, permitting deficiencies, financing shortfalls, and site control failures are the developer's responsibility and not recoverable from NS Power's ratepayers. Please provide a supporting document to support this claim.

Request IR-4:

Please provide a copy of the executed Power Purchase Agreement and interconnection agreement and highlight the provisions that require the customer to pay for the actual costs incurred by NS Power to develop the project, including any equipment costs as well as all future maintenance, repair, and replacement expenses noted in the application.

Request IR-5:

Will this network upgrade benefit future interconnection projects? If so, please describe how that benefit is accounted for in the current submission.

Request IR-6:

Please explain whether security for interconnection costs is being provided.

Request IR-7:

Once built and commissioned, will the project also provide benefits to NS Power's customers generally or is it only to benefit the solar generator?
