M12932 – Nova Scotia Power Inc. – Time-Varying Pricing Pilot Program – 2024/25 (Year Four) and 2025/26 (Year Five) Evaluation Reports

On June 30, 2026, Nova Scotia Power Inc. filed its 2024/25 (Year 4) Evaluation Report for the Time Varying Pricing Pilot Program with the Nova Scotia Energy Board. The report indicated that 2025/26 (Year 5) Evaluation Report would be filed with the Board by July 31, 2026. On July 7, 2026, the Board notified NS Power and interested parties of its decision to review the Year 4 and Year 5 reports concurrently. Subsequently, on July 31, 2026, NS Power filed the TVP Pilot Year 5 2025/26 evaluation report.

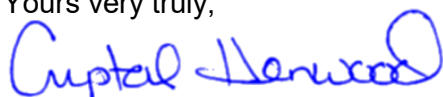
The Board has determined these matters will be reviewed by way of a paper hearing process and the following timetable will apply:
