

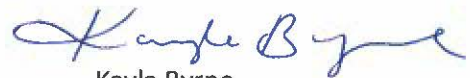

The Petition of Kayla Byrne, Municipal Clerk of the Town of Lunenburg, on behalf of its electric utility, the applicant, for an order authorizing and approving a new schedule of rates for electricity supply and service and/or schedule of rules and regulations in the Town of Lunenburg, respectfully sheweth the following particulars in support of this application, namely:

1. That the applicant is a public utility within the meaning of the **Public Utilities Act**, Chapter 380, Revised Statutes of Nova Scotia, 1989.
2. That the rates (or rules and regulations) presently in force have been effective since October 1, 2025, as ordered by the Board.
3. That in the opinion of the petitioner, certain changes in the Schedule of Rates are necessary due to the present financial requirements of the Utility, in particular, due to the NSPI Municipal Rate increases as of July 1, 2026 and January 1, 2027
4. That annexed hereto and marked Exhibit "A" is a copy of the Resolution of the Town of Lunenburg Council authorizing the Application.

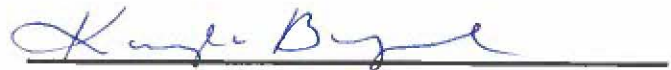
