M12972 – NSPI Complaint – Billing Issues - Nickerson

The Board determined that personal identifiers such as your mailing/civic address, your Nova Scotia Power account number, your personal email address, your telephone number and your meter number do not need to be made public for the purpose of determining this matter.

Your personal data identifiers that have been removed from the Board's website do not constitute "confidential" information within the meaning of the Board's Rules of Practice.

While the Board has an Access and Privacy Policy that protects personal data identifiers from disclosure to the public on the Internet, the paper version of the document is still open to public scrutiny by anyone presenting themselves at the Board's offices and making the request.

Despite this, staff are expected to refuse access to any record where they have reasonable grounds to believe that the person requesting access is doing so for an illegal or improper purpose.
