Please be advised that filing an appeal with the Board does not preclude NS Power from taking recovery action to recovery any arrears which are not the subject of the appeal.

You are further advised that information regarding appeals filed with the Board is a matter of public record and, while the Board will redact all personal identifiers from its published documents, they can be accessed by others through the Board's public website and in an un-redacted format at the offices of the Board.

The evidence you file in support of your appeal will also be a matter of public record unless you request that the Board hold some or all of the evidence in confidence. To do that, you must apply to the Board in writing pursuant to *Regulatory Rule 12*, a copy of which is attached to this letter. The evidence will, in any case, be made available to NS Power to allow the appeal to be properly addressed.

By copy of this letter, the Board requests NS Power to file a response with the Board to the enclosed appeal on or before **2:00 PM on Tuesday, August 4, 2026**, and to provide a copy of the complete file reviewed by the DRO in reaching its decision, including any supporting information and comments NS Power wishes the Board to consider. NS Power must also provide a copy of their response to you.

As the appellant, you will have **10 business days** to reply to NS Power's response should you wish to do so. The Board will then consider all information filed to determine if additional documentation is required to process the appeal.

The Board directs NS Power to place any disconnection notices on this property on hold until the Board issues a decision in this matter.
