Re: Town of Antigonish Electric Utility Flow Through Application for Large General Customer Rates

Dear Ms. Foster,

As you may be aware, St. Francis Xavier University is a member of the Large General rate class with the Town of Antigonish's Electric Utility (AEU). An historic ruling by the former Nova Scotia Utility Review Board (UARB) stipulates that the AEU's Large General rate align with the Nova Scotia Power Inc (NSPI) rate for the same class.

NSPI filed a general rate application in the fall of 2025 which the NS Energy Board approved with updated rates effective May 1, 2026. I am writing to advise StFX of the AEU's intention to file an Amendment Application (aka flow through application) in July 2026 for our Large General Service Demand and Energy rates. This notice serves as the minimum fifteen (15) calendar day notice required before filing this application with the NS Energy Board.
